## **Nebraska Alumni Association Plans UNL Spring Homecoming** *All alumni and fans invited to participate in dozens of campus activities*

The Nebraska Alumni Association invites the community to celebrate Husker Spiritfest, the University of Nebraska-Lincoln's annual spring homecoming. A variety of events, including guided campus tours, lectures, luncheons, the Red-White Spring Game and other athletic contests are planned across campus for the four-day celebration, which begins Thursday, April 15, and runs through Sunday, April 18.

In addition, six groups are planning reunions, including the class of 1960, Alumni of Color, Cather Hall/Custer House alumni, Love Memorial Hall alumnae, UNL Libraries former student employees and UNL Campus Recreation Center former employees.

"We encourage everyone, whether they're an alum or not, to participate in one or all of the Spirifest activities," said Diane Mendenhall, executive director of the Nebraska Alumni Association. "It is a wonderful opportunity to see firsthand the many exciting things happening on campus."

This year's schedule is highlighted by two special events on April 16—the **Jackie Gaughan Multicultural Center dedication** from 5-6:30 p.m. and the alumni association's **Football Friday Spring Game Edition** from 6:30-9 p.m. (doors open at 5:30). Both are free and open to the public.

The Jackie Gaughan Multicultural Center is a 30,000 square-foot building connected to the Nebraska Union. The space is available for all students and is intended to replace the old culture center on North 14th Street. Football Friday Spring Game Edition will include a spring game preview by local media personalities and former players and a special guest appearance by Dr. Tom Osborne.
